
1. Multiple choice questions (MCQ) 1×10=10

7. Answer short questions (5 short constructed response questions will be given and students will have to answer all of them) (Competency based) 10
8. Short Composition (Free writing or by answering a set of questions related to text. Capital letters, punctuations, spelling and sentence structure will be marked.) (Competency based). 10
9. Write simple personal letters (cues will be given and students will have to write a letter accordingly) (Competency based). 10
10. Short questions (Students will answer all questions by understanding instructions/ directions/ procedures to do any work) (Competency based). 1+2+2=5
11. Short questions (By using information related to days, weeks, months, time or cardinal & ordinal numbers in tables or columns students will answer SCRQs/ fill in the gaps.) 5
12. Arrange / Rewrite (Students will arrange or rewrite letters and words to make sense) 1×5=5

2. Take as much rice and curry as you need.
3. Chew gently for good digestion.
4. After finishing your food, wash your hands and clean your mouth.
5. Dry your hands and lips using a clean towel.

Q. What do you take at lunch as a meal?	Q. Why should you wash your hands with soap?	Q. How do you take your dinner?
<u>Sample Answer:</u> Rice and curry.	<u>Sample Answer:</u> To keep my hands clean or to get my hands free from germs. (or any logical answer)	<u>Sample Answer:</u> First I wash my hands and sit at dining table. I take my food. I chew it gently. Then I complete my food and wash my hands and lips.

Three Sample Items related to English Question No. - 11

Q.11. Write 5 sentences about your daily school activity considering the following points.

[Write the **time in numbers** and period sequence in **ordinal numbers** in your writing]

- What time does school start?
- How many periods do you attend?
- What time does each period begin?

Sample Answer:

My school starts at **10: 00** am. I have to attend seven periods every day. My **first/ 1st** class begins at **10: 00am**. **Second/ 2nd** class begins at **10: 45** am. **Third/ 3rd** class begins at **11: 20** am. (or any logical sentences that supports the question)

Q. 11. Fill in the gaps by writing **the time** so that the story makes sense.

My name is Dipa. I wake up at...(a)..... and I usually get out of bed at about(b)..... I take my breakfast at about...(c)..... School starts at...(d).... At.....(e).....we have thirty minutes lunch break.

Q. 11. Here is a TV schedule of programmes. Write five sentences using **days of the week** when you watch these programmes. Saturday is the first day of the week.

Schedule of TV programmes

Days of the week	Programme Title
1 st day	Cartoon programme
2 nd day	Football game
3 rd day	Cricket game
5 th day	News
7 th day	Cinema

Sample Answer: On **Saturday** I will watch cartoon programme. On **Sunday** I will watch football game. On **Monday** I will watch cricket game. On **Wednesday** I will watch news programme. On **Friday** I will watch cinema.

Question: Write 5 sentences about the games you play after school.(Sample) **10**
Remember to write in 5 sentences and use capital letters and full stops and correct spelling.

Possible Answers (Sample)	Marking guidelines	Marks(10)
Content could contain: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Introduce the games they play. • Description of how they play. • Their favourite game. • How they play their favourite game? • Who they play with? • When they play? • Where they play? 	For content, one mark should be given for each sentence written to the topic (total of 5 marks). In this marking section punctuation, spelling and handwriting should not be marked. Mark only whether the student is able to express his/her ideas so that the marker understands what is written.	5 marks
Sentence Structure	All sentences have correct structure (noun, adjective, verb)	2 marks
	Up to two sentences incorrect	1 mark
	More than two sentences incorrect	0 marks
Spelling	All words are correctly spelt (up to 5 incorrect words allowed)	1 mark
Capital letter and Punctuation	All correct	2 marks
	Up to 5 mistakes	1 mark
	More than 5 mistakes	0 marks
